Purpose:

The Municipality of WestLake-Gladstone provides curbside collection of household waste and recycling in the urban areas of Gladstone, Plumias and Langruth (garbage only). The Municipality is committed to recycling as much material as possible to ensure the longevity by reducing waste entering the municipal waste disposal grounds.

1. GENERAL OPERATIONS:

- All Curbside pick up schedules will be set by the Director of Operations
- All waste/recycling must be placed at the curb by 8:00 a.m.
- If waste/recycling is placed at the curb the night prior to pick-up it must be placed in a receptacle container with a lid.
- Maximum weight of any bag is 50 lbs.
- All curbside collection must be placed, for all properties which have a maintained/accessible back lane, in the back lane.
- No Loose garbage will be picked up.
- All receptacle containers must be free of odour and loose debris.
- All receptacle containers must be kept clean.

2. WASTE:

Residential Curbside Household Waste:

- All household waste is to be placed in garbage bags.
- There is a two-bag limit for all household garbage. (approximately 190 litre receptacle) No bag or container lined with a bag shall be more than 50lbs.

- Small individual pieces/bundles under 50 lbs. must be securely tied and is equivalent to one of the two bag limits.
- All additional bags (over two bag limit) must have a tag on the bag prior to staff picking up additional bags.
- Tags can be purchase at the municipal administrative office.

Commercial Waste:

- Employees will **NOT** enter any buildings to retrieve waste
- All garbage must be in garbage bags

3. RECYCLING:

Household Recycling:

- Recycling must be in clear (transparent) bags.
- Glass collection will be the third (3rd) Thursday of each month.
- Glass must be kept separate from all other recycling by placing in a cardboard box or clear bag.

Each household is responsible for maximizing their recycling capabilities and ensure they contribute to eliminating the amount of waste entering the waste disposal grounds.

Commercial Recycling:

- All cardboard must be flattened
- Recycling must be in clear bags
- Glass curbside collection will be third (3rd) Thursday of each month.
